The Wee Wedges: Ages from 6 – 9 4:30 pm to 5:30 pm

(Wee Wedges must be 6 years of age by June 1st 2017)

All the participants must attend our rules and etiquette class and pass a test on the rules of golf. The tests are geared toward their playing level and age.

- Each instructional session will run for 1 hour based upon age group.
- All instruction will be given at the driving range or on the course when is space available.
- Make up dates will be held one week after the completion of camp.
- Each class session will have a maximum of 14 students per class. The student/instructor ratio of 7:1 will ensure plenty of individual instruction time.
- The camps will cover the golf swing from top to bottom, and will also stress golf etiquette and the rules of the game.
